## Fiscal Year 2024-25 Emergency Energy Assistance

- In Fiscal Year 2024-25, Operation Fuel accepted applications between 9/16-10/6/24, and 1/27-2/28/25.
- We approved 5,665 households, serving 13,775 residents, and providing over \$2.6 million in emergency assistance.

### Of approved clients in FY 2024-25:

- 16% reported being out of fuel/ shutoff.
- 44% reported being low on fuel or pending shutoff.
- 54% reported a vulnerable aged (under 6; over 60) household member.
- 55% identified as homeowners; 45% as renters.
- Clients' (mean) SMI is approximately 32%, and client family size at 2.3. This means our clients' average income is approx. \$30,000 annually.
- 37% of households qualified for CEAP; 13% for SSI.
