Updated December 18 with data requested at meeting December 3, 2025

Emergency Energy Assistance Program

Cycle 1, September 2-10, 2025: Complete.

- 1,649 applications received, 1,060 approved households; \$517,325.84 committed funds.
- 72% clients applied independently; 28% with Application Support Center assistance.
- 14% applicants applied demonstrating CEAP eligibility; 13% with SSI.
- 12% indicated the household was out of fuel or experiencing shutoff.
- 53% households Renters/ 47% Homeowners (approved)
- 30% expressed medical need, disability
- 51 Veteran Households
- Energy mix breakdown: 59% utility applications, 41% fuel applications

Cycle 2, November 2-10, 2025: Under Review.

Of received applications for Cycle #2:

- 1,520 applications received.
- 78% applied independently; 22% applied with Application Support Center assistance.
- 17% applicant households applied demonstrating CEAP eligibility, 10% with SSI.
- 10% of applicant households reported a current shutoff/out of fuel.
- We can provide data on the breakdown of renters/ homeowners, medical need, and veteran status after completing cycle review (by 12/31/25).
- Energy mix breakdown: 57% utility applications, 43% fuel applications





3) Breakdown of applications submitted through application support centers (in person) or directly by clients through our online portal.

We can provide this data for Cycle 1, which is complete.

Of the 1649 total **applications received** in Cycle 1, 72% clients applied independently. Of the total number of **approved grants**, 63% applied independently, and 37% with ASC support.

Of **approved homeowner clients**, 69% applied independently, and 31% through an ASC.

Of **approved renter clients**, 57% applied independently, and 43% applied through an ASC.
